Draft Position Scoring

Elite prospect: Top-10 pick	10 points
Round 1: Picks 11-32	8 points
Day 2: Rounds 2-3	4 points
Day 3: Rounds 4-7	2 points

NFL (Rookie Season) Scoring

Rookie of the Year	10 points
All-Pro selection	6 points
Pro Bowl selection	4 points
Regular-season starts	1 point for every start

NFL (Years 2-5) Scoring

League MVP	5 points per award
Offensive Player of the Year	4 points per award
Defensive Player of the Year	4 points per award
All-Pro selection	3 points per appearance
Pro Bowl selection	2 points per appearance
Regular-season starts	0.5 points for every start

Note: If a player had won multiple awards as a rookie or in Years 2-5, he wasn't able to double- or triple-dip; he received only the points earned for his highest accolade. For example, a rookie who won Rookie of the Year, was named an All-Pro and made the Pro Bowl with 16 starts on the season would earn 26 points (10 points from awards and 16 points from starts). For Years 2-5, a player could earn a maximum of 13 points per season (5 points from awards and 8 points from starts).
