GENERAL INFORMATION

How do I access the 2022 NFL Draft in Las Vegas, NV April 28th through April 30th? Access to the NFL Draft is FREE for all ages. For free entry to Draft Experience, fans are required to register for NFL OnePass at NFL.com/OnePass.

When will the 2022 NFL Draft be held?

The 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light will take place Thursday, April 28 through Saturday, April 30, 2022.

Draft Experience Hours:

- April 28: 12pm—9pm PT (or end of concert)
- April 29: 12pm—9pm PT (or end of concert)
- April 30: 8am—5pm PT (or end of concert)

Draft Theater Hours:

- April 28: 3:30pm—9pm PT (or end of concert)
- April 29: 2:30pm—9pm PT (or end of concert)
- April 30: 8am—5pm PT (or end of concert)



Where is the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light located?

The 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light will take the stage in Las Vegas at the heart of the Strip, with NFL Draft Experience and the Draft Theater located behind the High Roller and The LINQ, adjacent to Caesars Forum. For maps of the NFL Draft event site, visit HERE.

How can I watch the 2022 NFL Draft on television?

The 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light will be televised nationally by NFL Network, ABC, ESPN and ESPN Deportes. Are there concerts or performances going on during the NFL Draft?

Yes. Weezer, Ice Cube, and Marshmello will perform FREE concerts, live at the Draft Theater stage following each night of the Draft as part of the NFL Draft Concert Series presented by Bud Light. Concert viewing is on a first-come first-served basis and standing room only.

But that's not all! In the heart of the strip, the Draft Red Carpet Stage presented by Gillette Labs will host performances by entertainers like the Jabbawockeez, Cirque du Soleil, and Blue Man Group. Visit NFL.com/OnePass for your free entry to the NFL Draft Concert Series presented by Bud Light.

NFL DRAFT EXPERIENCE

What is NFL Draft Experience?

NFL Draft Experience is a FREE, family-friendly football festival celebrating the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light, held at the heart of the Strip behind the High Roller and The LINQ, adjacent to Caesars Forum, from Thursday, April 28 - Saturday, April 30. Fans of all ages and teams will be able to participate in interactive exhibits, immersive games, virtual reality experiences, free player autograph sessions, and more! Do I need tickets for the NFL Draft Experience?

No. All events are free and open to the public. Fans will be required to present proof of registration with NFL OnePass online or via our mobile app for entry to the NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater. With the Theater situated directly adjacent to Draft Experience, viewing will be available of the stage itself and on multiple screens throughout the event site.

Will I have a view of the Draft Theater within Draft Experience?

Because the NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater are situated adjacent to one another, fans attending Draft Experience will be able to view Draft picks and concerts. There will be screens throughout Draft Experience, as well as space to view the stage accessible on a first come, first serve basis.

Draft Experience attractions will also be running simultaneously with the Draft and those attractions can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Does the Draft Experience accept cash at concessions or NFL Shop?

The event will be completely cash-free, no cash will be accepted.

Do I have to pay to participate in the NFL Draft Experience?

NFL Draft Experience is **FREE** to the public and does not require a ticket, however, each fan must register with NFL OnePass, either by downloading the NFL OnePass App in the app store or by visiting www.NFL.com/OnePass, in order to enter on a first come, first serve basis.

When is NFL Draft Experience open?

NFL Draft Experience is open on the below dates and times (PT):

- Thursday, April 28: 12PM-9PM PT (or post-concert)
- Friday, April 29: 12PM- 9 PM PT (or post-concert)
- Saturday, April 30: 8 AM-5 PM PT (or post-concert)

What is the schedule of activities?

The activities do not change daily, the attractions will remain open for all hours of operation. The Draft will begin at the Draft Theater at 5pm PT on Thursday, 4pm PT on Friday and 9AM PT on Saturday.

What NFL players will be signing autographs at the Draft Experience?

The full schedule of player appearances will be available in the OnePass app beginning Friday, April 22. Updates to the schedule are ongoing and any appearances are subject to change.

Are there age limits on any of the activities at NFL Draft Experience?

Yes, the football clinics conducted on the NFL Play Football Field are open to kids ages 6–14 only. The other various passing, running, kicking and receiving games and attractions are for fans of all ages once the adult has registered for NFL OnePass (including minors).



Can I bring in outside food or beverages?

Outside food or beverages are not permitted. Food and beverages will be available for purchase within the concession areas around the Draft site.

What is the plan in the case of bad weather?

NFL events are commonly held in inclement weather. Only in the case of extreme weather that threatens public safety will the event potentially be postponed. In the unlikely event that such a situation occurs, information for fans will be available on NFL.com/Draft, pushed out via the NFL OnePass app and announced over the PA system on-site.

How many people will be allowed to attend the NFL Draft Experience?

While there is no set capacity for the event, fans who have registered for OnePass will be admitted to the NFL Draft Experience on a first come first served basis, and security will closely monitor capacity to ensure the safety of all attendees.

Can I speak to a customer service representative?

What are the entry requirements?

All fans will go through airport level screening and must adhere to our prohibited items list found <u>HERE</u>. Fans are also required to register for **NFL OnePass** at NFL.com/OnePass.

What is prohibited at NFL Draft Experience?

The NFL Draft, including NFL Draft Experience and the Draft Theater, is a smoke-free environment. The use of tobacco products and e-cigarettes is prohibited. For a complete list of Prohibited Items at NFL Draft, please see HERE.

Security screening in and around the NFL Draft Experience will be significantly heightened. All items carried by fans will be carefully inspected and potentially prohibited from entry.

<u>Note</u>: Prohibited items and items determined to be inappropriate for entry into the secure perimeter will be the responsibility of the fan and cannot be accepted, stored or checked by the NFL or the Las Vegas Metro Police Department.

Fans are strongly encouraged to refrain from bringing any type of bag to the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light.

What is permitted at NFL Draft Experience? Bag Policy:

• Bags smaller than 16x14x12 are permitted and are subject to x-ray screening



- Small purses/clutch bags will be carried through screening
- Size exceptions will be made for medically necessary items
- Large bags can be secured at provided lockers

<u>Strollers -</u> Strollers and baby carriages are permitted, however all bags and blankets must be removed and screened by x-ray and will be physically/visually inspected.

<u>Cameras</u> – Small cameras and binoculars will be permitted. Professional grade camera and recording equipment will only be permitted for properly Draft Credentialed media

<u>Reusable Water Bottles</u> – Fans will be allowed to enter with an empty, reusable water bottle for filling when in the perimeter.

NEL DRAFT THEATER & MAIN STAGE

What is the Draft Theater and Main Stage?

All three days of the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light will be held at the Draft Theater on the Draft Main Stage behind the High Roller and The LINQ, adjacent to Caesars Forum. On the Draft Main Stage, Commissioner Goodell and other special guests will be announcing the player selections of each of the 32 NFL teams.

What is the Draft Theater? How do I get tickets?

The Draft Theater houses the Main Stage where prospects will "take the stage" to be selected to their new teams, as well as a daily concert series following the rounds. Although fans can enter a standing room area to view the Theater at no cost, seating within the Theater is available only to select ticket holders.

What is the Inner Circle? How do I get tickets?

The Inner Circle is where select fans are invited by their teams to view the Draft Main Stage from within the Theater. The tickets for this section are exclusively distributed by the clubs.

What time do Inner Circle guests need to arrive for check in?

Inner Circle check in will run from 3:00PM-4:15PM PT Day 1 and 2:00PM-3:30PM PT ET Day 2.



Inner Circle guests will be required to be in their seats **no later than 4:15PM PT** on Thursday night for Round 1.

Where will Check-In take place for Inner Circle guests?

Inner Circle check in & ticket scanning will take place on the southside of the Draft Theater located within the Draft Experience area. The Inner Circle is a ticketed section & all participants MUST download the NFL TicketHolder App to access their tickets for entry.

If I'm in Draft Experience, can I go to the Draft Theater?

Yes! Because the NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater are located adjacent to one another, fans will have the ability to flow freely between the two areas. However, fans may only enter the standing room section of the Draft Theater as tickets are needed to access the seated area.

Note: Once ticketholders exit the Draft Theater, there is no re-entry.

How do I access my ticket to the NFL Draft Theater?

Fans who have a ticket to attend the NFL Draft presented by Bud Light within the Draft Theater will need to download the NFL Ticketholder App in order to access their mobile ticket and receive key "Know Before You Go" information. The NFL Ticketholder App can be downloaded for Android (LINK) OR iOS (LINK) device.

If I am coming from NFL Draft Experience, will I be required to go through security screening again to enter the Draft Theater?

No. Fans will not be required to be screened for a second time to enter the Draft Theater after going through screening to enter NFL Draft Experience.

Will fans be permitted to flow in and out of the Draft Theater?

Ticketed fans with seats in the Theater will not be permitted to flow in and out of the Draft Theater; however, there will be access to concessions, retail and restrooms. Once guests are ready to leave, there is no re-entry. The Standing Room Only viewing area will allow fans to flow between the Draft Experience and the Theater viewing area.

Will there be concessions within the Draft Theater?

Yes. Food and beverage items will be available for purchase inside the Draft Theater.

When do I need to be in my seat in the Draft Theater?

Fans who have tickets to view the NFL Draft presented by Bud Light within the Draft Theater should plan to arrive early to go through security screening and arrive at their seats in time. *Note: fans will forfeit their seat within the Draft Theater on Thursday, 4/28 if they are not seated by 4:50PM.*



NFL OnePass

What is NFL OnePass and is it required to enter NFL Draft Experience?

NFL OnePass is your digital key to making the most out of attending NFL Draft Experience Events. Fans can download the app in the App Store or on Google Play. Alternatively, fans can register on www.nfl.com/onepass to receive their QR code. Registration is FREE for NFL OnePass – no purchase necessary.

OnePass is required to enter NFL Draft Experience and gives fans the ability to:

- Receive exclusive event information
- Speak with the NFL's virtual concierge, Vince
- Enter for chance to win prizes, including a trip to Super Bowl LVII in Arizona!

How do I win prizes?

In the app, you will find in the navigation bar "My NFL." Click on "My NFL" to view a list of badge locations where you can check in with your NFL OnePass. Once you have checked in at a badge location, the badge will "light up" (i.e. appear in color versus black and white).

The more badges you earn, the more prizes you qualify to win. Prizes are not guaranteed to all fans. You will be notified via text message or email if you have won so be sure to enter your correct information when you register.

Please visit NFL.com/OnePass for official rules. You must be over 18 to be eligible to win.

What happens if I register for NFL OnePass before I download NFL OnePass app?

Once you've downloaded the app, you will be directed to a screen with a "login" button. Please click on the button and login with your NFL.com account. Your NFL OnePass will appear in the app on the top right corner for easy access.

Who can I contact if I have an issue with the NFL OnePass app?

Please email OnePass@nfl.com for any issues or locate a guest services booth on-site at an NFL event.

What is the age requirement for NFL OnePass registration?

You must be over the age of 18 to register for NFL OnePass. Fans registering will be required to accept the waiver to complete their registration and participate in interactive games. During registration, adults will have the opportunity to add up to 5 minors. If you forget to add a minor during registration, you do not need to re-register. Your QR code will be scanned multiple times based on the number of minors (up to five) participating in the activity.

What happens if I enter incorrect information during registration?



If you entered incorrect information during registration, you will have the ability to edit your mobile phone number in the app. Navigate to the "More" section and click on "Edit Profile". Please note at this time, no other additional information can be updated.

What happens if I forget to enter the minors attached to my NFL OnePass during registration?

You do not need to re-register. Your NFL OnePass QR code will be scanned multiple times based on the number of minors participating at that activity.

Will minors have their own NFL OnePass?

No. Only adults over the age of 18 will have an NFL OnePass QR code. Each adult must have their own QR code.

What if I do not have a smart phone?

You may register for NFL OnePass on your desktop or onsite at the NFL OnePass kiosk location. To register on your desktop, please visit NFL.com/OnePass. If you register on-site at an event, you will receive a business-size card with your QR code. For all other methods of registration, fans will receive their NFL OnePass via email.

Fans may also write down the code they receive upon registration to present as proof of registration onsite.

COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFFTY PROTOCOLS

Are there COVID-19 policies or procedures in effect for the event?

The NFL will follow all state, local & CDC guidelines as it relates to health & safety protocols in place at the time of the event. At this time, NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater guests will not be required to show proof of vaccination on-site. Wearing a mask or face covering is recommended for anyone who is unvaccinated or considered high risk. Additionally, we ask any guest or fan that is feeling unwell, even if the symptoms are minor, not to attend any Draft-related events.

Hand sanitizer stations are available throughout the venue. Fans and staff are encouraged to use these and wash their hands regularly.

Are face coverings required at the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light?

No. Masks are not required at any of the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light venues, including NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater. Wearing a mask or face covering is recommended for anyone who is unvaccinated or considered high risk. The NFL welcomes and supports anyone who may choose to wear a mask and, will provide them throughout the event site as requested by fans in attendance. Additionally,



we ask any guest or fan that is feeling unwell, even if the symptoms are minor, not to attend any Draft-related events.

How will the NFL Draft Experience look with regards to COVID-19 restrictions?

Fans will be required to comply with Covid-19 health and safety protocols to enter the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light. Such protocols may change according to then-current public health guidance and applicable law. Protocol updates will be made available prior to the Event. Please visit NFL.com/Draft for more information and updates prior to the Event.

Is First Aid available?

First Aid is located within the NFL Draft Experience near the Clinic Field. In addition, medical personnel will be positioned throughout the NFL Draft, including within NFL Draft Experience and the Draft Theater.

SECURITY PROTOCOLS

How will you create a safe environment?

The NFL is committed to maintaining a safe environment for all attendees at the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light. Security screening in and around NFL Draft Experience will be significantly heightened at each entrance. All items carried by fans will be carefully inspected and potentially prohibited from entry into the NFL Draft Experience and Draft Theater. The number of guests entering and leaving the premises will be closely monitored for the safety of our fans.

Are cameras and video cameras allowed into the NFL Draft Experience?

Small cameras and binoculars will be permitted. Professional grade camera and recording equipment will only be permitted for credentialed media. If you are a member of the media, contact Kyle Whatnall (kylew@bzapr.com) to coordinate access.

Is there a clear bag policy at Draft Experience?

No. The Bag Policy at the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light permits any bags smaller than 16x14x12; however, all bags will be subject to x-ray screening. For full security procedures, including our Bag Policy, please see HERE.

FAMILY FAQ

Do NFL Draft fan events have private nursing rooms or changing tables?

Yes. All Fan Services locations at NFL Draft Experience are accessible and equipped with baby changing tables and private space for nursing mothers.



Can I bring my stroller and diaper bag to NFL Draft Experience?

Yes, strollers are allowed, subject to screening. There is a special security check for medically necessary items.

Are pets allowed at the NFL events?

Yes, service animals (dogs, and in some cases, miniature horses trained to perform work/do tasks for a fan because of a disability) and service animals in training are permitted into the Draft venues and may accompany fans with a disability in all public areas of Draft events (where other fans are permitted). However, other animals, including household pets and emotional support animals will not be admitted.

ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

Is there an accessible entrance to NFL Draft Experience?

All entrances at the NFL Draft presented by Bud Light are accessible. If you require additional Mobility Assistance, please proceed to a Guest Services booth. Mobility Assistance Teammates will be available to issue wheelchairs to attendees who request them. For accessibility and guest information locations, check out our event site maps: <u>HERE</u>.

Accessible Viewing Areas

The NFL Draft Theater will be located at the heart of the Las Vegas Strip behind the High Roller and The LINQ, adjacent to Caesars Forum. It is free and open to the public. The NFL Draft presented by Bud Light is a fully accessible event and there will be closed captioning provided on multiple viewing screens, as well as a mobile device solution to deliver the closed captioning to a website that fans can access on their phones.

Video Captioning

As a service to our guests who are deaf or hard of hearing, throughout the NFL Draft Experience site there will be caption enabled video screens. Within the Draft Theater, there will close captioning as well as a section dedicated to those who are hard of hearing, with an ASL sign language interpreter standing by. Additionally, information will be provided for fans on site to view closed captioning from their personal phone through a secure website.

Fans with Mobility Disabilities

The 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light is accessible for fans using mobility devices. Notwithstanding, please note that: (i) it is a large venue with great distances between activities and attractions; (ii) it is



outdoors and situated in parking lots and across city streets and pathways; and (iii)some travel is over natural terrain and terrain designed for motor vehicles (therefore, if it should rain, there could be mud). Wheelchairs, power wheelchairs, and three or four-wheeled scooters are allowed only for use by fans with mobility disabilities. For safety reasons, requests to use of other power-driven, mobility devices will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Powered wheelchairs may also be charged at an Accessibility Center/Fan Services Center. Fans should bring all cords and accessories needed to charge their devices. Chargers must use a 110-volt, 20-amp circuit.

Accessible portable toilets are available at the ends of each bank of portable toilets throughout the venue within NFL Draft Experience and are available at each restroom location for the Draft Theater.

Special Dietary Needs

Outside food and drink is not allowed inside the NFL Draft event, unless a fan has special medical dietary restriction.

A fan requiring insulin or an EPI pen can bring his or her medically necessary materials and medications provided all medicine has a prescription label with the fans name. Out of concern for the festival staff and volunteers who handle the trash, fans should dispose of medical waste and syringes in the proper disposal located at the medical tent (see First Aid section and check out the First Aid locations on our event site maps <u>HERE</u>). Guests should not dispose of these items in other trash bins at the festival.

NFL Draft Experience will have food vendors that provide special dietary options. Please visit an Accessibility/Fan Services Center for a full list of menu options and further information.

Service Animals

Service animals (dogs, and in some cases, miniature horses trained to perform work/do tasks for a fan because of a disability) and service animals in training are permitted into the Draft venues and may accompany fans with a disability in all public areas of Draft events (where other fans are permitted). However, other animals, including household pets and emotional support animals will not be admitted.

LAS VEGAS TRAVEL

How can I get to the 2022 NFL Draft?

Monorail and public transportation are recommended as the most efficient means for travel to the 2022 NFL Draft presented by Bud Light. The Monorail can be taken to the "Bally's and Paris" station for the closest entry access point to NFL Draft Experience and the Draft Theater. Is there a special pick-up and drop-off area for ride sharing services?

There is a recommended and dedicated ride share and taxi drop area located at the Tuscany Suites & Casino located at 255 E Flamingo Rd, Las Vegas, NV 89169. It's just under a half mile walk to the entrance of the Draft Experience. To see where rideshare is located at the NFL Draft, check out our event site map HERE.

What are the options for public transportation in Las Vegas?

Where can I park for the 2022 NFL Draft?

Parking will be extremely limited near the NFL Draft and at your own expense. Monorail and public transportation are recommended.

The Las Vegas Convention Center, located at 3150 Paradise Road., Las Vegas, NV 89109, will offer convenient and free parking in its Silver Lots 1 and 2 as well as Bronze lot to access the Monorail from the Las Vegas Convention station.

Park and Ride via The Deuce will also be available at Cashman Field (located off LV Blvd N.) with stops also at the Mob Museum and Bonneville Transit Center. All routes will drop off/pick up off E. Flamingo Rd., just west of Paradise (in front of Starbucks in the Hughes Center). From there, it's approximately a ½ mile walk to the entrance of the Draft Experience.
